WHAT TO DO IF YOUR IDENTITY WAS STOLEN

- File a report with the Federal Trade Commission at www.identitytheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338.



- Contact your financial institution if the ID theft involved a credit/debit card or bank account number.
- Report identity theft to your local law enforcement agency, to the credit reporting agencies, and to any other relevant government agencies, including driver's license, US Mail, Social Security and the IRS.
- Request a fraud alert or credit report freeze from the credit reporting agencies.
- Change passwords and personal identifying numbers on any compromised accounts.
- Monitor bills and credit card statements and dispute any new accounts or fraudulent activities.
