SCHEDULE REMINDERS

Veterans Day Closure - Monday, November 11th

If you receive meals on Mondays, you won't automatically receive a replacement meal the previous week. If you need a meal for this closure, call us to discuss your needs by Monday, November 4th.

Thanksgiving Day and Thanksgiving Friday Closure - November 28th & 29th

If you receive meals on Thursdays or Fridays, frozen meals will automatically be delivered earlier in the week. If you don't need them, please call us by Wednesday, November 20th.

Christmas Holiday Closure - Tuesday, December 24th & Wednesday, December 25th

If you receive meals on Tuesdays or Wednesdays, you won't automatically receive a replacement meal for this closure. If you need a meal, call us to discuss your needs by Monday, December 9th.

New Years Day Closure - Wednesday, January 1st

If you receive meals on Wednesdays, you won't automatically receive a replacement meal earlier in the week. If you need a meal for this closure, call us to discuss your needs by Thursday, December 26th.

Senior Center Closures - The Longmont Senior Center will be closed: November 11th, 28th, 29th; December 25th; and January 1st.
