WHAT IF YOUR IDENTITY IS STOLEN

- File a report with the Federal Trade Commission at www.identitytheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338.
- Contact your financial institution if the ID theft involved a credit/debit card or bank account number.
- Report identity theft to your local law enforcement agency, to the credit reporting agencies, and to other relevant government agencies, including driver's license, US Mail, Social Security and the IRS.
- Request a fraud alert or credit report freeze from the credit reporting agencies.
- Change passwords and personal identifying numbers on any compromised accounts.
- Monitor bills and credit card statements and dispute any new accounts or fraudulent activities.
